Great comment. Hope they take it to heart.

There are apparently two forum threads for this one black window issue. I solved this issue for me and at least one other person in that other thread so I am now bringing that solution over into this thread since Google needs help with such things apparently (I thought they would have done this earlier had I even suspected that the Google mods wouldn't have done this on their own. Two of them emailed me to thank me for the fix so I figured they would have made it available to others who needed it. Anyway, it is my hope that this fix also works for you and your co-workers.

Fixed the 100% black Google Chrome issue.

Here is what worked for me...

- 1. Unpin Chrome icon from task bar so it is on the desktop.
- Right mouse click on said icon and left click on Properties.
- Click on Shortcuts tab
- 4A. In Target window, add this exact text: [space]--disable-gpu"
- 4B. The end of the text string in the Target window should now read: ...chrome.exe" --disable-gpu"
- 5. Double click on the desktop icon and Chrome should open correctly. If you want, you may pin this icon to the taskbar.
- 6. Left single click on the "Customize" icon in the top right, which is the 3 horizontal lines icon. Select "Settings" from the list.
- 7. Select "Show advanced settings..." at the bottom.
- 8. Deselect "Use hardware acceleration when available."
